## New features and improvements

The following improvements have been made in this release of the Viewer.

**Note:** Improvements to the API may also affect the Viewer. For detailed information about new features and improvements in the API, see the *Workplace Forms™ Server What's New* document.

### Installers

Three installers are now provided for the Viewer:

- The standard installer (approximately 61 MB) is a multi-language installer that installs the standard (multi-language) Viewer (including the JVM) and several sample forms (see below).
- Two reduced file size installers are also provided:
  - The first reduced file size installer (approximately 19 MB) is an English-only installer that installs the (multi-language) Viewer without the JVM and without the sample forms.
  - The second reduced file size installer (approximately 30 MB) is a multi-language installer that installs the (multi-language) Viewer without the JVM and without the sample forms.

You may want to use the reduced file size installers if download times are an issue (for example, if users must download the Viewer over a dial-up connection) and your forms do not call Java™ extensions or use Web services. Java extensions and Web services require a JVM on the user's system. (If you can ensure that your users already have a supported JVM on their system, then you can call Java extensions or use Web services in your forms. ### Sample forms

Sample forms are now installed with the Viewer (when installed via the standard installer). To access the forms, click **Start** → **Programs** → **IBM Workplace Forms Viewer 2.6** → **SampleForms**.

### Portal 6.0 support

The Viewer can now render forms within IBM® WebSphere® Portal 6.0.
