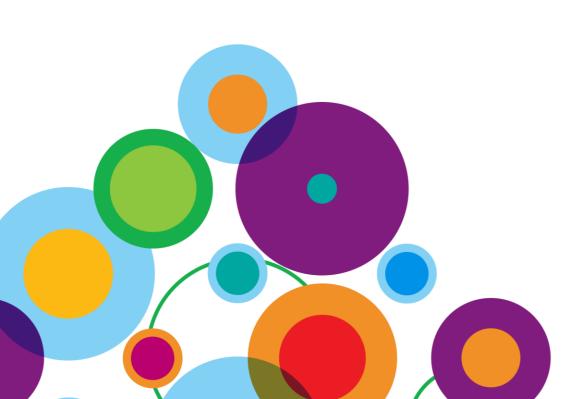

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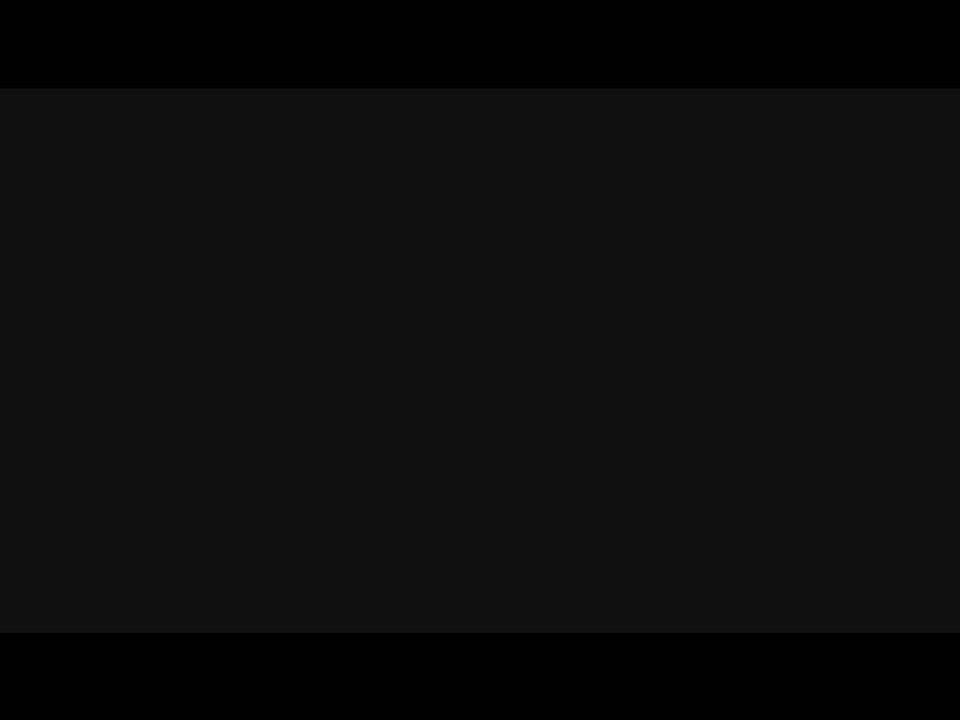

The Establishment of First KFC Store

 It all began in 1968 when Jim Collins accepted the Franchise for Queensland and the first KFC restaurant open in July 1969 at Kedron, Brisbane



The Start of Sizzler expansion

 In 1984, Jim Collins was visiting Brisbane and together with Australian staff, decided to try a Sizzler Restaurant here. The first Sizzler Restaurant in Australia was established in July 1985 at Annerley, Brisbane

Objectives of the Project

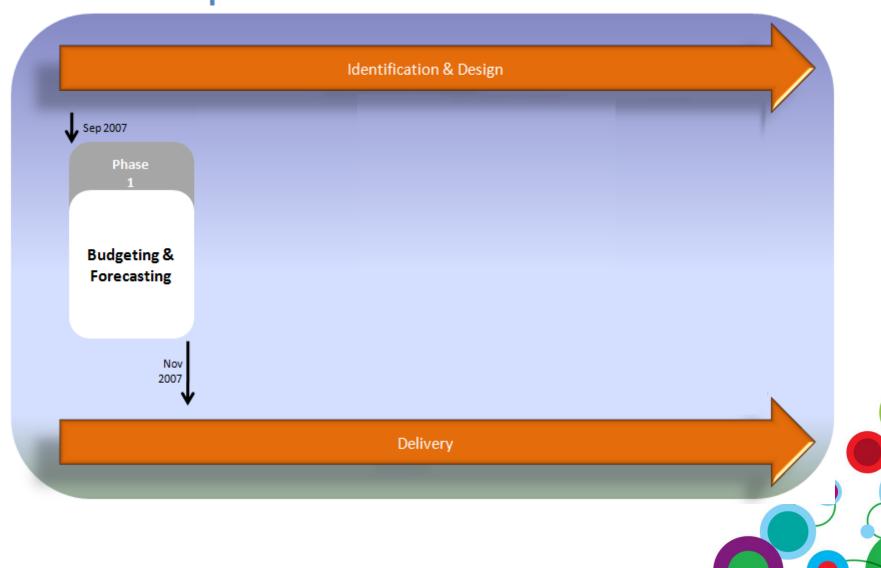
- Flexibility through expansion and growth
