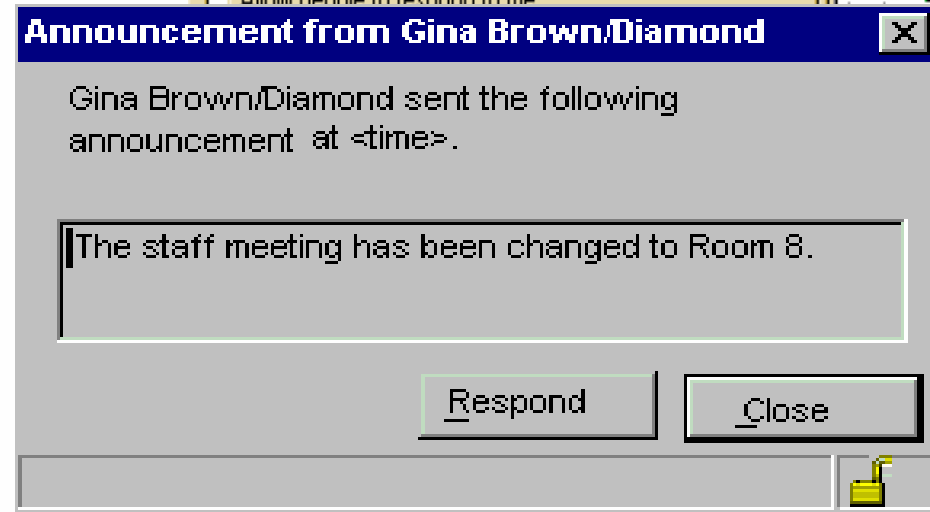
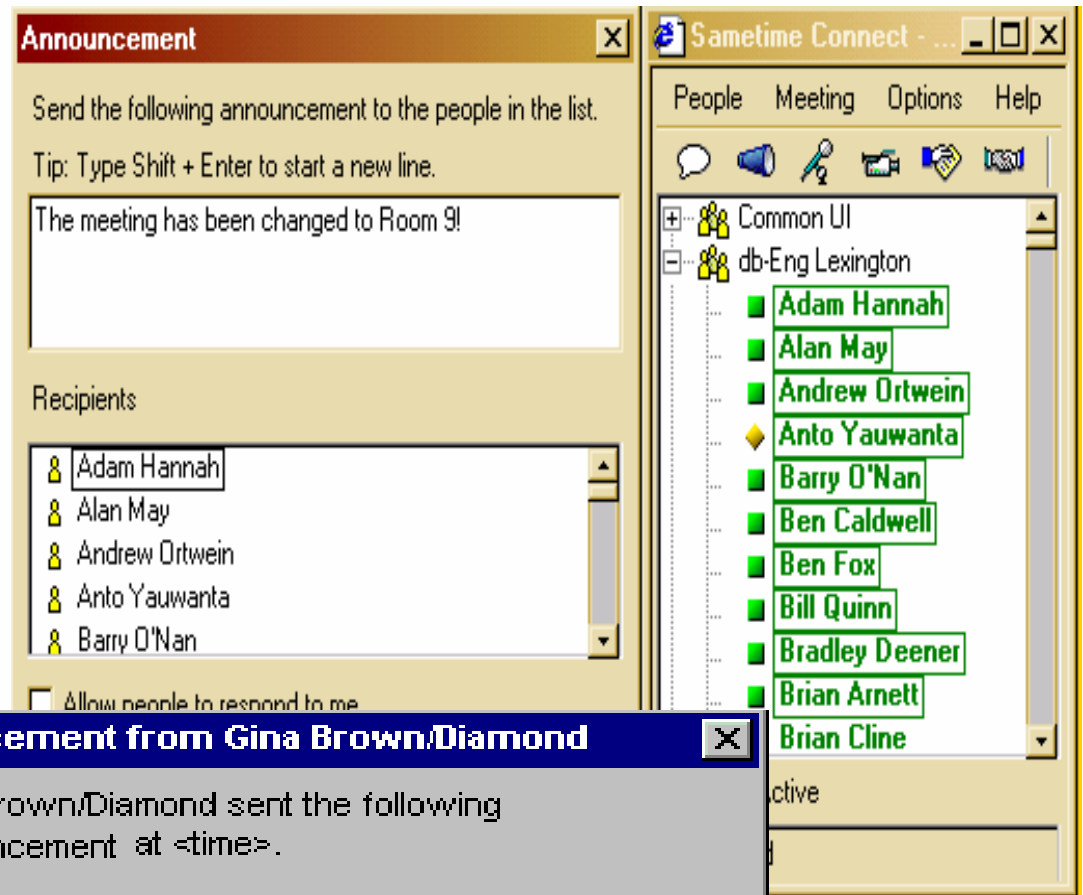
# Send Files to Online Users

- Admin has complete control: limit the file size, or turn off this feature altogether
- ✓ Provides context and content in chats
- ✓ Fewer e-mail attachments means smaller Inboxes, less wasted server space



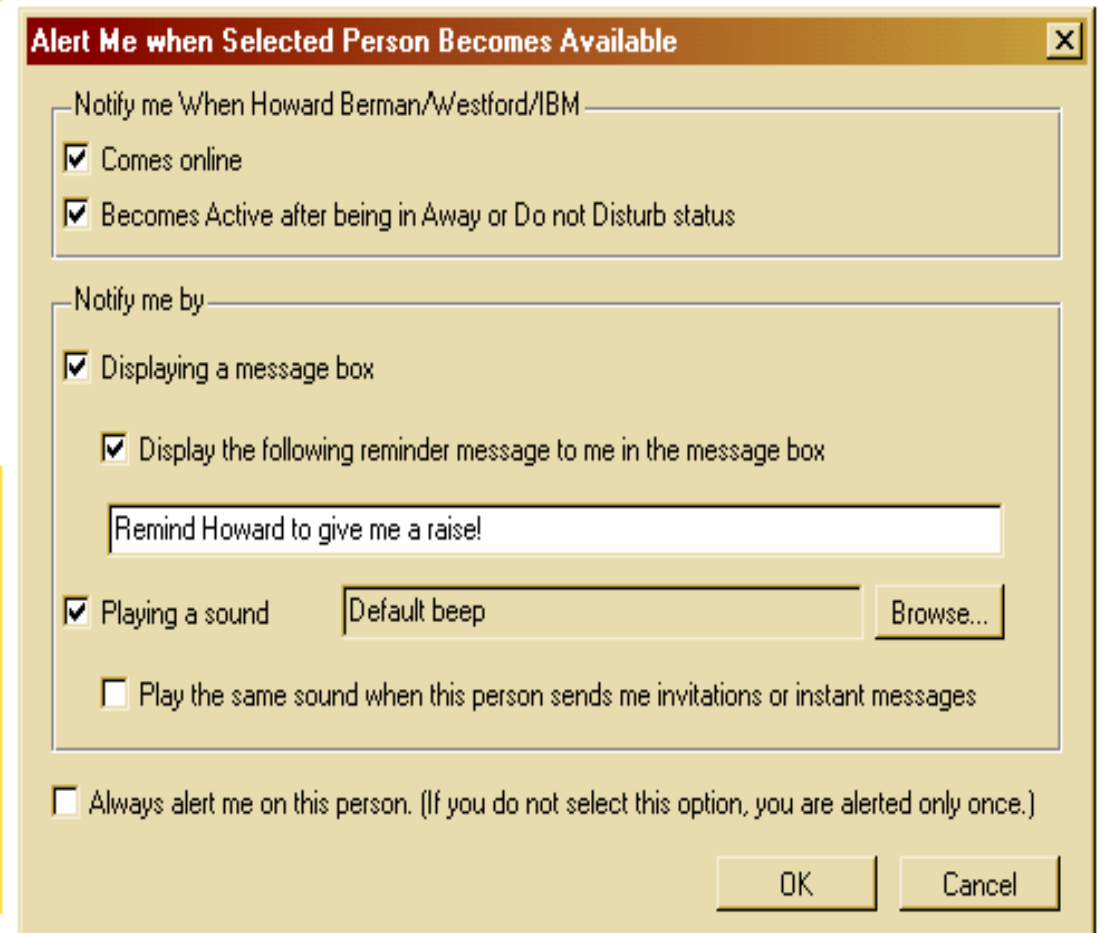
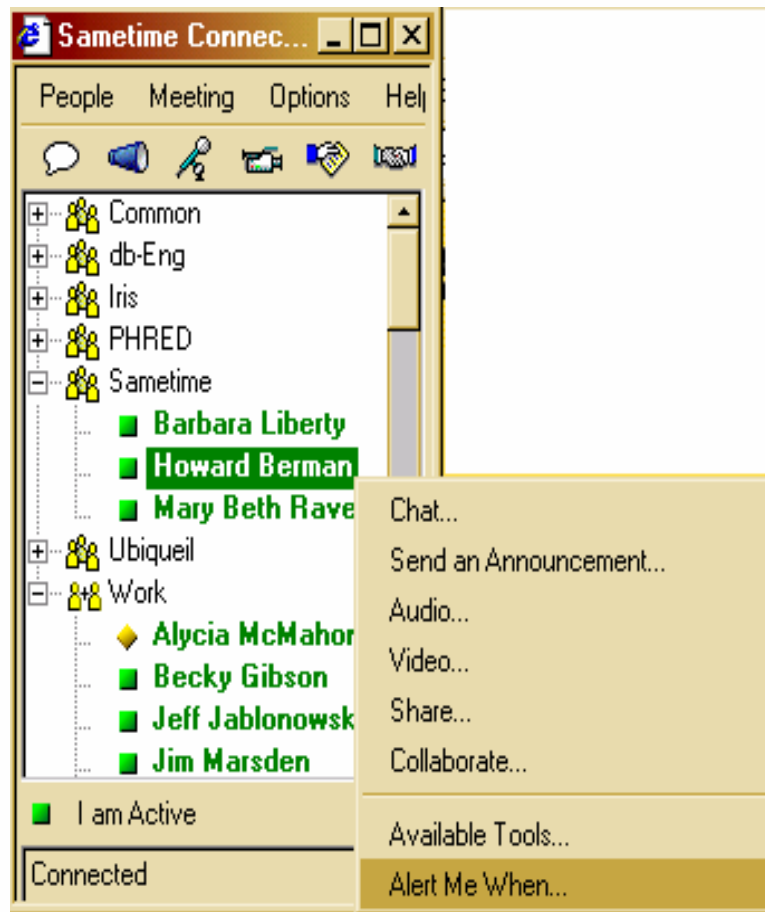
# Send Announcements

- One-way “broadcast” to one or many people
- Administrator can disable
- ✓ Easier than ever to send important, timely information to a group
- ✓ Programmable; use to provide application-level alerts


# Session Initiation Protocol (SIP) Gateway

- Connects one SIP-compliant community to another
  - Users can add “external” Sametime users to their contact list
  - Users exchange presence and instant messages with members of the “other” community
  - Based on emerging SIP standard
  - Cross-community traffic secured by SSL when both communities use Sametime
- ✓ IBM leads the industry by delivering the first standards-based platform for cross-community collaboration



# Single Sign On

- Supports Domino SSO via Lightweight Third Party Authentication (LTPA)
- Also enables SSO based on Netegrity SiteMinder, WebSphere Policy Director, etc.
  - Backward compatibility: choose between SSO or the former “Secrets and Tokens” method
- ✓ Can be the basis of SSO with Lotus QuickPlace, others

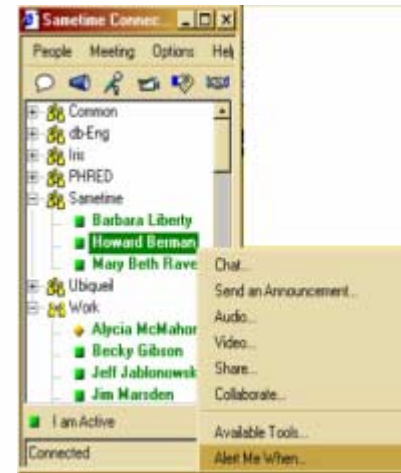
# New agent for Meeting Management

- Agent automatically deletes Meeting documents when they reach a certain age (optional)
  - Configured by the Administrator
- ✓ Automates Meeting Center housekeeping
- ✓ Database doesn't get unmanageable



# Admin API

- New API provides access to Meeting, Presence, IM events
  - Example: customized monitoring/logging
  - Example: Trigger application events when a user comes online
  - Example: Send IM from application X when user Y comes online
- ✓ Provides new way to integrate real-time collaboration with other applications and environments



# Lotus QuickPlace 3.0 Integration

- QuickPlace optionally “comes alive” via Sametime
  - Awareness in place
  - Chat in place
  - Schedule team’s online meetings in the place’s team calendar
- ✓ Teams will work together in new ways, whether they need immediacy or persistence, asynchronously or in real-time

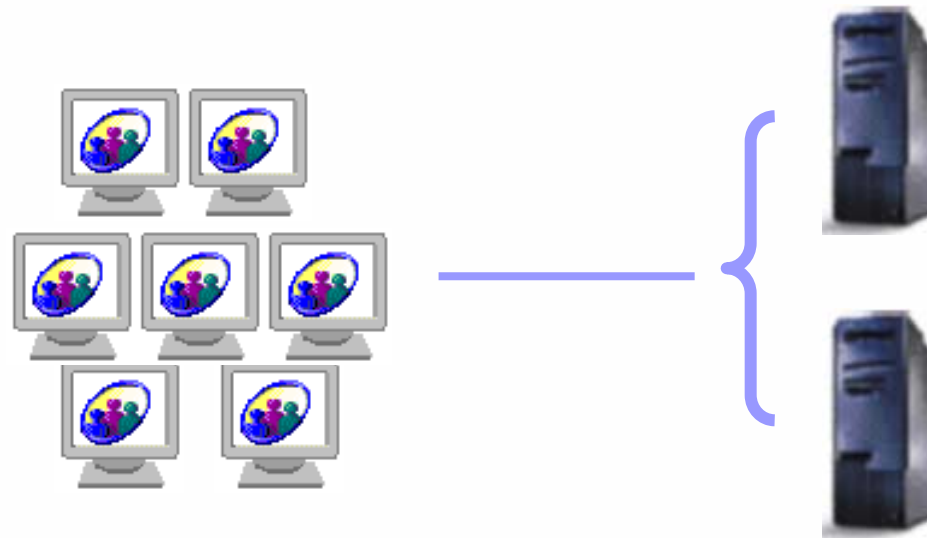
# Sametime 3 - Microsoft Outlook Integration

- Sametime is seen as a Resource of Exchange
- ✓ Partners using COM toolkit have real-time enabled Outlook with “Sametime Links”
