If the search string you specify is imprecise, the number of 'hits' returned to you can be too large to be useful. To make the search results more useful, you can:

- Use as specific a search string as possible.
- Modify your '[Acrobat Search Preferences](#)'.
- Exclude irrelevant books from the search by unchecking them from [this list](#).

To add a book to the search list, add its index file. For example, to add the CTG Programming book index, choose 'Indexes' then 'Add' from the Search box, and follow this path to the index file:  
..docs\en\_US\books\ctg library\ctg programming\cclhak00.pdx

If you have Adobe Acrobat Catalog™, you can create your own searchable indexes for groups of books that you refer to frequently.
