The database administrator is responsible for database performance, data integrity, database security and database troubleshooting.

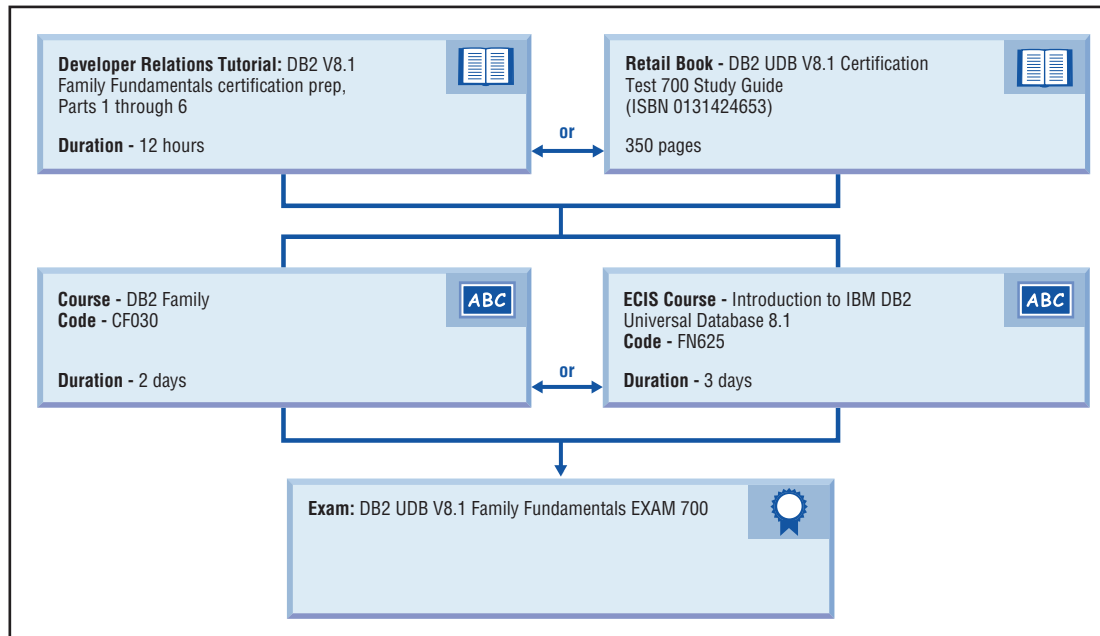
Assumption

Objectives

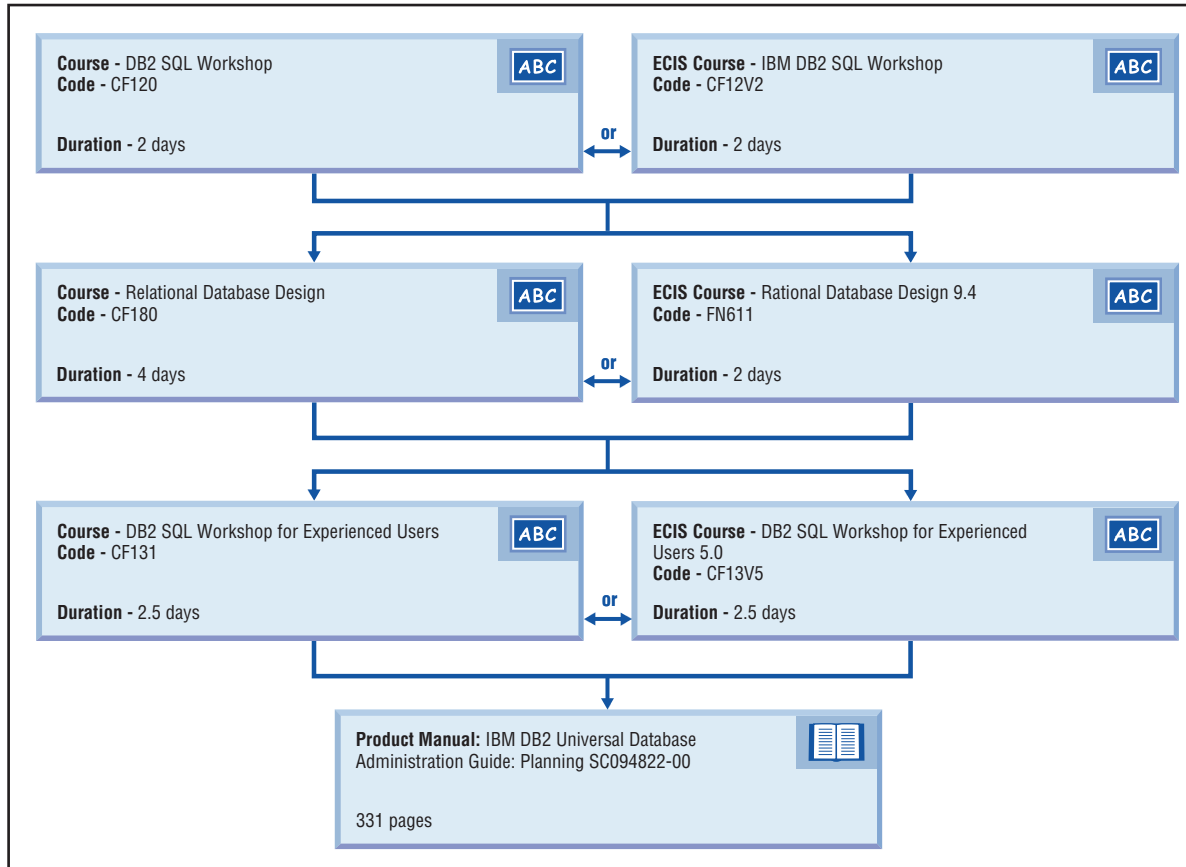
1. General operations administrator skills

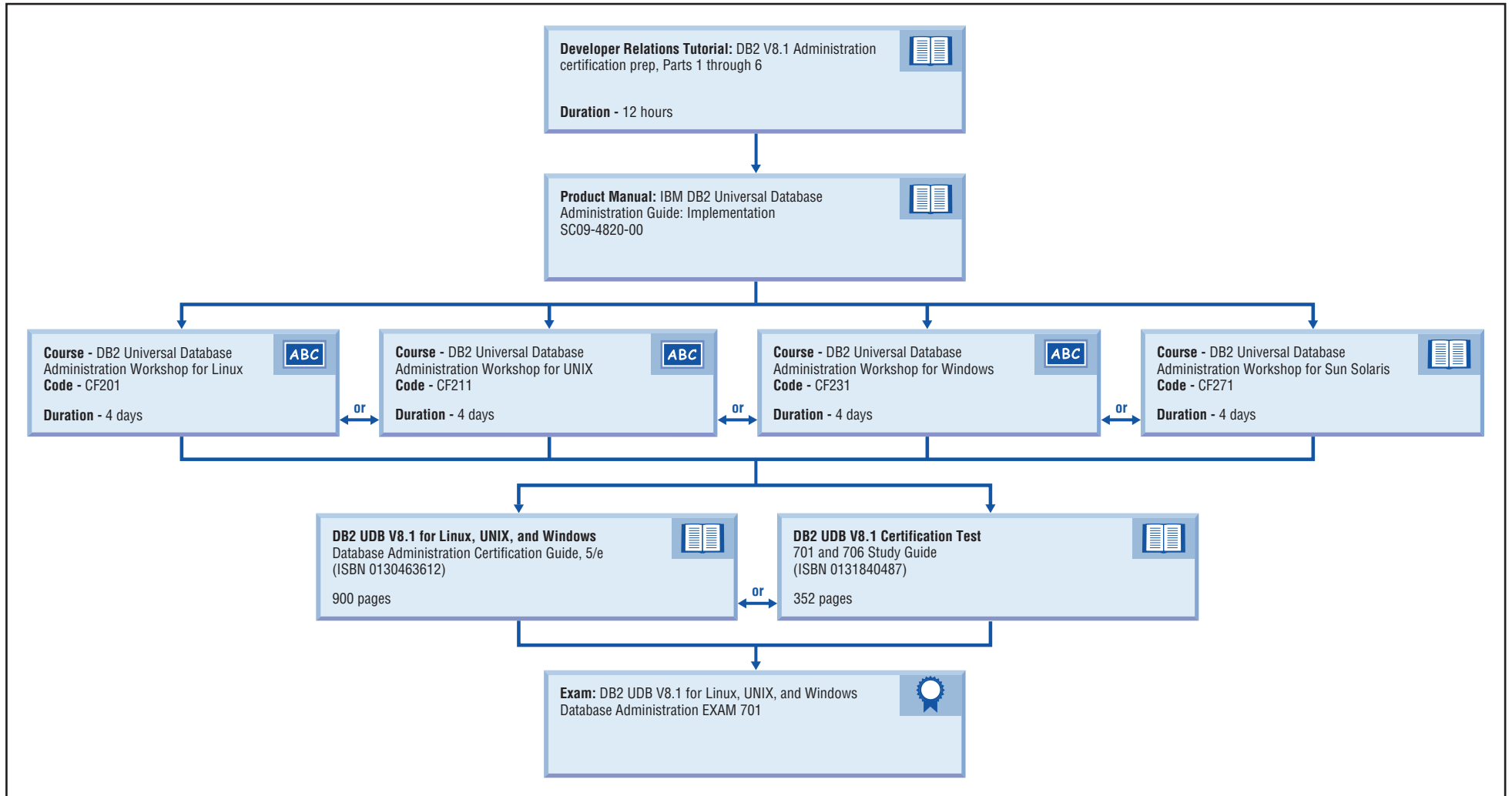
