## **E48 Controlling Your IMS Message Queues**

IMS QCF offers you the option to monitor and control the IMS Queue. Using a set of ISPF screens you are able to query, browse, and delete selected queue entries. You are also able to monitor and control the IMS queue utilization. A set of control statements allows you to instruct QCF how to handle a situation where the queue is beginning to get in trouble. QCF will gradually shut down (IWAIT) callers who are using excessive amounts of the queue space. If you get to the point where the queue is in danger of overflowing, every caller will be IWAITED until action is taken to fix this. ISPF screens allow you to query, browse and delete any in-process IWAITED queue. Come to this session and see how this function works.
