This session addresses how and when to use functions of IMS Connect 1.1 to communicate with the client application, what is required by the user written message exit, how you can customize the user init exit, how asynch output is supported by different versions of IMS and changes to the structures of the IRM, RSM, CSM and OTMA headers. Learn about synch level, commit modes and socket type usages. Unicode support, conversational and non-conversational transaction flows, local support using a non-TCP/IP interface and configuration file parms mapping are among the other topics discussed.
