IMS message queues are critical IMS Transaction Manager resources that can be local in one IMS or shared between several IMS images. To perform more accurate problem resolution of your queues, IBM now offers a tool that provides easy access to and helps manage all aspects of your IMS messages queues— the IMS Queue Control Facility.

Come to this session to learn how to use the IMS Queue Control Facility tool to monitor the usage of your existing queue space and respond to notifications when problems are encountered in a timely manner. This topic covers how to browse and query your existing queues to determine usage by various IMS entities, such as input or program output. Hear how to use this tool for unloading input and output data that is flooding your queue, saving it for additional processing and reloading it after fixing the problem if required. The session also discusses how to view message content as well as browsing and unloading of specific queue entries.
