




IMS Runs the World...

- Most Corporate Data is Managed by IMS
 - Over 95% of Fortune 1000 Companies use IMS
 - IMS Manages over 15 Billion GBs of Production Data



IMS for a Highly Secure Environment

- z/OS provides high level Security Standards to measure against
- IMS exploits many of the z/OS security features
- RACF and/or IMS may be used to secure any or all
 - ► IMS transactions, databases, commands, terminals, APPC/IMS logical units (LUs), MSC links, control region and dependent regions, program specification blocks, etc.





Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act

- Major Health Insurance Reforms
 - assuring insurability, coverage
- Strengthens the healthcare system
 - enhances affordability, combats fraud/abuse, data interchange standards, consumer protection also:
- Requires enhanced security and privacy of individuals' medical information
- Provides for Stiff Civil and Criminal Penalties for noncompliance
- Rule Compliance Date: April 14, 2003 (small plans 2004)

Bundesdatenschutzgesetz (Federal Data Protection Act)




- This Act serves to implement directive 95/46/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 October 1995 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (OJ EC no. L 281, p. 31 ff.).
 - The purpose of this Act is to protect the individual against his right to privacy being impaired through the handling of his personal data.
- This Act shall apply to the collection, processing and use of personal data by (1)Public bodies of the federation, (2)Public bodies of the data protection is not governed by Land legislation (3)private bodies in so far as they process or use data by means of data processing systems or collect data for such systems, process or use data in or from non-automated filing systems or collect data for such systems, except where the collection, processing or use of such data is effected solely for personal or family activities.








HALDB (High Availability Large Database)



Large Database

- Databases are partitioned
 - Up to 1001 partitions per database
 - Partitions have up to 10 data set groups



HALDB

High Availability Database

- Partition independence
 - Allocation, authorization, reorganization, and recovery are by partition
- Self healing pointers
 - Reorganization of partition <u>does not require</u> changes to secondary indexes or logically related databases which point to it
 - Prefix Resolution, Prefix Update, and secondary index rebuilds are eliminated

Up to 10,010 data sets per database! (Greater than 40 terabytes)

 - Theoretical limit is now over 40 terabytes


The Big Picture: JDBC Access to IMS Data






