Technology Description

Content Transformation Services (CTS) is a technology that simplifies the process of moving content and metadata between various repositories. It does this by a standardized document definition. Regardless of which repository or which taxonomy, all documents and their classification can be represented in this standardized xml-based approach. Document classifications can be transformed from one taxonomy to another to simplify the exchange of content and metadata between systems or between parties.

CTS goes beyond the typical approach of simply connecting to multiple repositories. By abstracting the content and metadata, it can be unlocked and re-used in ways never before possible. Documents can be exported from one system for later import to another without the need for direct connection or integration between the two. Alternatively, if both systems are simultaneously available, content can be copied directly from one to the other.

Export, import and migration of content can now be performed with the ease of drag and drop. In addition, repository taxonomies can be reported and compared against each other even for different systems.

CTS is integrated with IBM FileNet P8, IBM FileNet Content Services and Lotus Notes.
