The Red Brick Warehouse (6.1) provides data warehousing and decision support for analytic and business intelligence applications. IBM intends to continue to enhance, sell and support this product for customers and business partners and to fulfill our plans to deliver a new release (6.2) in the first half of 2002.

The themes for the 6.2 release are integrated analytics, performance and ease of use. By including support for ANSI standard SQL/OLAP extensions we will add to Red Brick's strong analytic capabilities. Performance and usability will be enhanced with features such as built-in performance monitor, locally segmented indexes, remote loads, integrated backup & restore, and support for XML. IBM Red Brick Warehouse 6.2 will build on Red Brick's reputation as an easy-to-use, high performance data warehouse engine and continue to offer key functionality required in the demanding business intelligence market.

In addition IBM has begun planning for the 6.3 version of Red Brick Warehouse.
