Other Relevant Information:

бел.руб shouldn't be considered a proper currency sign. It's just an abbreviation from **белорусских рублей** or **беларускіх рублёў**. Our real practice is the following. Just numbers are usually specified on the price tags. The full currency name should be specified in official agreements and important payment bills. If there is no special reference to USD, "y.e." or "усл.ед." it means that the sum is specified in Belarusian roubles. Both "y.e." and "усл.ед." means *conventional units*. This is a half-hidden reference to USD (the sum may be presented in Belarusian roubles according to the current USD/BYB ratio).
