IBM z/OS Connect EE – New Support inside CICS



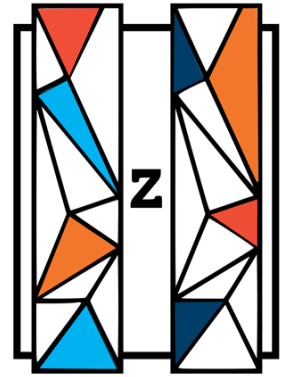
