System requirements and prerequisites

The following minimum hardware levels are required to run IBM File Manager® plug-in for Eclipse V11.1.0.0:

- CPU Intel® Pentium® 4 or equivalent.
- RAM 768 MB in addition to the operating system requirements.
- Hard disk 500 MB available space.

One of the following levels of Windows operating system software is required to install IBM File Manager® plug-in for Eclipse V11.1.0.0:

- Microsoft® Windows® XP 32-bit
- Microsoft Windows Vista 32-bit
- Microsoft Windows 7 32-bit
- Microsoft Windows Server 2003 32-bit
- Microsoft Windows Server 2008 32-bit

The following levels of software required to install IBM File Manager® plug-in for Eclipse V11.1.0.0:

- CICS ExplorerTM (for Windows) V1.0.1, or later
- File Manager® for z/OS Version 11.1 or later with the PTF for APAR PM34376

Installing IBM File Manager® plug-in for Eclipse into CICS ExplorerTM

The following steps are required in order to install IBM File Manager® plug-in for Eclipse into CICS ExplorerTM environment:

- 1. Download and install <u>IBM CICS ExplorerTM</u>
- 2. Download a zip file containing IBM File Manager® plug-in for Eclipse. Find the latest version from <u>IBM z/OS Problem Determination Tools</u> site. The zipped file is called **cn0m.zip**.
- 3. Start CICS ExplorerTM
- 4. Click **Help > Software updates...**.
- 5. Under Available Software tab, click Add Site....
- 6. In Add Site dialog, click Archive... button and select the zipped file.
- 7. Select **IBM File Manager® plug-in for Eclipse** feature from the list. Optionally you may need to select and install **EMF run-time for IBM File Manager® plug-in for Eclipse** if your CICS Explorer[™] environment does not have a version of EMF run-time environment installed.
- 8. Click Install... button to install IBM File Manager[®] plug-in for Eclipse. Upon successful installation, the CICS ExplorerTM should prompt you to restart the CICS ExplorerTM. Select **Yes** to re-start your CICS ExplorerTM.

After following the installaton steps above, you should be able to start using IBM File Manager® plug-in for Eclipse. Follow the steps below to bring up **Systems Information** view:

- 1. Select Window > Show View > Other....
- 2. From a list of available views, select Systems Information view under File Manager category.
- 3. You should see Systems Information view in your perspective.
