

***ICMS Alert:***                      ***Error in Bulk Number Change Code***

During work on the new ICMS release under development, a problem was found with the Bulk Number Change function. An earlier ICMS Y2K fix introduced an error that may cause corruption of some ICMS data if a Bulk Number Change operation is performed. The Lab developed a code fix and created a suite of programs to perform a data fix if it is required.

**Code fix:**      Contact your Level 2 Service Center for installation instructions, save files, and prerequisites.

For input to the data fix program, note the number ranges changed and the disconnect date used when the Bulk Number Change was performed. If this information is not available, a report produced by the data fix programs may assist in determining the information.
