Lab exercise: Working in dashboards

Objectives

In this lab, you complete these tasks:

- ▶ View requirements artifacts
- ▶ Customize your User Dashboard

Given

- ▶ The JKE Banking Money That Matters project

Task 1: View requirements artifacts

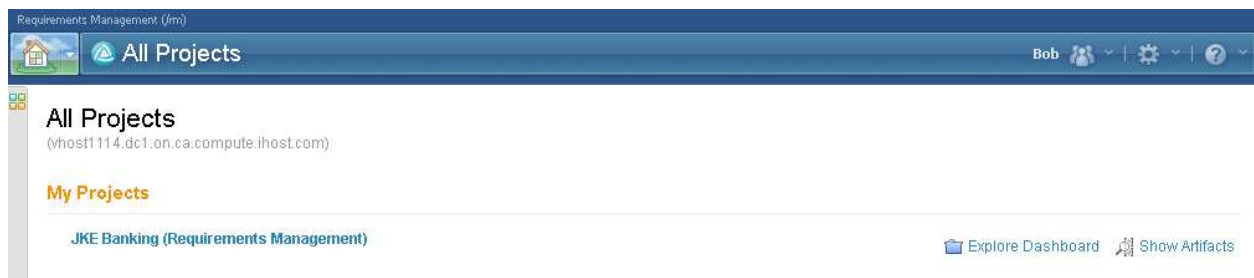
In this task, you explore the Rational Requirements Composer interface.

1. Log in to Rational Requirements Composer with these credentials

- User ID: bob
- Password: bob

Tip: Login credentials are case-sensitive, so be sure to enter bob in lowercase in both fields. After your credentials are accepted, Rational Requirements Composer opens to Bob's dashboard.

2. On the All Projects page, under My Projects, click Explore Dashboard to open the JKE Banking (Requirements Management) project dashboard.



3. Explore the JKE Banking (Requirements Management) project dashboard.
 - a. What types of information are available in the dashboard widgets on the General tab?
 - b. What types of information are available in the dashboard widgets on the Development tab?
4. On the main menu, click Artifacts > Browse Artifacts.

From the Artifacts page, answer these questions:

- a. What are some of the tags that have been defined for this project?
- b. What are some of the views that have been defined for this project?
5. Expand and explore the folders of the JKE Business Recovery Matters Project and answer these questions:
 - a. Based on the folders that you see, what requirement types have been defined for the project?
 - b. Click the Business Goals folder to view its contents in the artifacts list. Using the rich hover feature, what is the priority that is assigned to the business goal artifact **Give Back**? What is its status?
6. Use the quick search to find the feature artifact **Donation by Amount**.

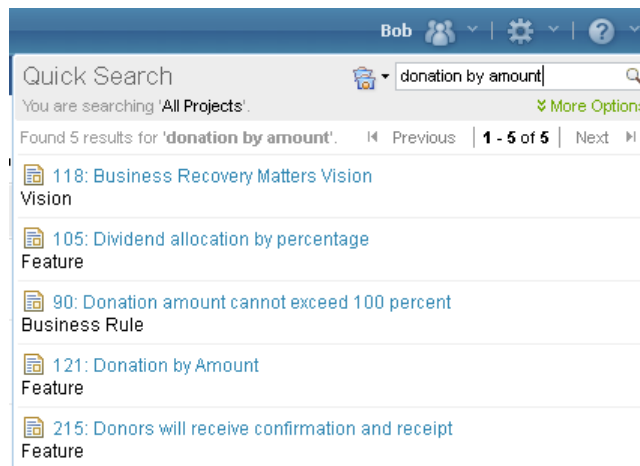


Figure 1.: Find artifacts using quick search.

7. Open the **Donation by Amount** feature artifact and answer these questions:
 - a. What is the origin of this requirement?
 - b. What is the current status?
 - c. Is this requirement included in any collections? If so, which?
 - d. Does this requirement have any defined links? If so, what are they?
8. Use the breadcrumb to navigate back to the JKE Banking (Requirements Management) project.

Task 2: Customize your User Dashboard (optional)

1. From the **User Profile** icon menu, click **Open My Personal Dashboard**.

2. Move (drag) the Reviews widget from the middle column to the third column; place it over the top of the Comments widget.
3. Add a widget that displays only recent changes to Storyboard artifacts in the JKE Bank project:
 - a. On the Recent Changes widget menu, click **Duplicate Widget**.
A duplicate widget is placed on the dashboard.

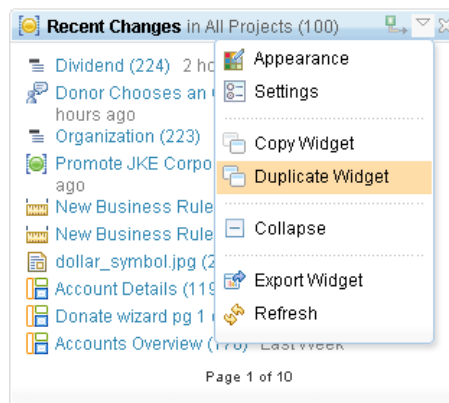


Figure 3.: *Duplicate Widget command on the widget menu.*

- b. In the new widget, on the widget menu, click **Appearance**.
 - c. Change the widget title to JKE Banking Storyboard Changes, and click **OK**.
 - d. On the widget menu, click **Settings**.
 - e. For the **Project** field, click **Select**, select **JKE Banking (Requirements Management)**.
 - f. For the **Artifact Types to show** field, click the menu arrow, click **Storyboard**, and click **OK**.
4. Use the **Home** menu to navigate back to the JKE Banking (Requirements Management) project.
