## Provisioning Policy Preview

-Changes in a provisioning policy can impact a large number of accounts.
-Resource intensive changes need to be planned in advance.
-The provisioning policy preview feature allows administrators to identify the accounts affected by a provisioning policy change in advance.

## Compliance Alerts

## - Alerts

- Messages that contain information about noncompliant accounts
- Delivered as e-mail and items on the to-do list
- Alerts generated
- Alert enforcement action on the service
- Noncompliant account
- Not triggered by:
-Policy previews
-Granting changes

## Customizing Compliance Alerts

-Configure who receives the alert.
-Configure when it will be escalated and to whom.
-Configure the actual notification message.


## Allowed Values in Service Attributes

- Controlling allowed values with null
- Attribute created with no value
- Null returned from JavaScript
- Enforcement column
- Mandatory
- Default
- Optional
- Excluded
