# IBM® WebSphere® Everyplace® Deployment V6 Downloading Software Prerequisites



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## Supported Environments

- Single System
- Windows® 2003 server (32 bit version)
  - ▶ Standard or Enterprise Edition
  - ▶ With or without Service Pack 1
- Minimum 1Gb memory
- User Registries:
  - ▶ Local Database Registry
  - ▶ Microsoft Active Directory 2003

## Prerequisite Software

- DB2® Universal Database 8.2.2
  - ▶ Enterprise Edition
  - ▶ Workgroup Server Unlimited Edition
  - ▶ Workgroup Server Edition with a 5 user minimum
- Version 8.2 + FixPak 9a (FixPak 9 is also supported)
- The database must be installed locally; remote database is not supported.

•FixPak 9 is not available anymore. If a customer already has FixPak 9 installed, they do not need to upgrade to FixPak 9a, but it is recommended.

## Prerequisite Software


- WebSphere Application Server V 6.0.2.0
  - ▶ WebSphere Application Server 6.0 ..... + Refresh Pack 2
  - ▶ IBM HTTP Server 6.0 .....+ Refresh Pack 2
  - ▶ Web Server Plug-ins 6.0 .....+ Refresh Pack 2

•FixPak 9 is not available anymore. If a customer already has FixPak 9 installed, they do not need to upgrade to FixPak 9a, but it is recommended.

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## Downloading DB2 UDB 8.2

- DB2 Universal Database Workgroup V8.2
  - ▶ Search for “DB2 UDB Workgroup Server Unlimited Edition V8.2 for Windows”
  - ▶ There are 3 products returned. Pick the “32-bit” one.
  - ▶ This will download C58PLML.exe
- DB2 Universal Database Enterprise V8.2
  - ▶ Search for “DB2 UDB Enterprise Server Edition V8.2 for Windows”
  - ▶ There are 3 products returned. Pick the “32-bit” one.
  - ▶ This will download C58RSML.exe

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- Download base prerequisites from IBM Software Access Catalog
- \* DB2 Universal Database Workgroup V8.2
  - Search for “DB2 UDB Workgroup Server Unlimited Edition V8.2 for Windows”
  - There are 3 products returned. Pick the “32-bit” one.
  - Should download C58PLML.exe
- \* DB2 Universal Database Enterprise V8.2
  - Search for “DB2 UDB Enterprise Server Edition V8.2 for Windows”
  - There are 3 products returned. Pick the “32-bit” one.
  - Should download C58RSML.exe

## Downloading Application Server 6.0

- WebSphere Application Server V6.0
  - ▶ Search for “WebSphere Application Server V6.0”
  - ▶ Scroll to and select the product entry indicating “WIN 2003”
  - ▶ This will download C587VML.zip



- Download base prerequisites from IBM Software Access Catalog
- \* WebSphere Application Server V6.0
- Search for “WebSphere Application Server V6.0”
- Scroll to the product entry indicating “WIN 2003”
- Should download C587VML.zip

## Downloading 6.0.2 Refresh Packs

- Click on “Recommended Updates”
- Click on version 6.0
- Locate the section for 6.0.2 and click on Windows
- Download the following:
  - ▶ Intel Application Server
  - ▶ Intel Plug-ins
  - ▶ Intel IBM HTTP Server



## Downloading DB2 UDB FP9a

- Click on “DB2 Universal Database Version 8 FixPak 9a”
- Click on “32 bit DB2 UDB for Windows ...”
- Locate the section for No. 9a
- Download the appropriate update:
  - ▶ DB2 Workgroup Server Edition
  - ▶ DB2 Enterprise Server Edition

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
