

Web mailbox feature overview

- Why web mailbox feature?
 - Enables partners to participate in business-to-business transaction with just browser alone.
 - This allows partners, customers, and vendors to interact with the hub using the supported browsers, web based support for business-to-business interaction.
- Facilities provided by web mailbox :

Inbox : Lists set of documents received from various internal partners.

Download : Facility to download the received documents.

Outbox : Lists set of documents routed. - Upload : Facility to upload/ route documents.
- Status : Monitor the Status of the business documents

Facilities provided by web mailbox:


Inbox: Lists set of documents received from various internal partner.

Download: Facility to download the received documents.


Outbox: Lists set of documents routed.

Upload: Facility to upload/ route documents.


Status: Monitor the Status of the business documents.




Hub administrator tasks includes enabling the Inbox and Outbox module.




Hub administrator also gives the read write permissions for Inbox and Outbox



A user is created for the external partner and it is made a member of webuser group to get the functionality of webbox




Login as the external user that you have created. Inbox and outbox tabs are available when logged in as external user.




To send a document using outbox choose "send file".

Browse for the document to send and the internal partner to which the document needs to be sent.


Send the document in production or test mode.



This slide shows a snapshot of outbox after sending the document. It also shows the status of the document sent.



External partner can have a Webbox gateway. Documents sent to the webbox gateway are seen in the Inbox of the external user.
