



CPP/CPA editor is introduced as a new feature in WebSphere® Partner Gateway V6.2







Overview of CPP/CPA editor

- What is CPP/CPA editor
 - It is an editor, which helps you in creating and modifying CPP/CPA
- How one can invoke CPP/CPA editor.
 - ▶ CPP/CPA editor is delivered as an eclipse plug-in. You need to extract the plug-in into any of the eclipse frameworks to make use of the editor. After extracting the plug-in, you have to open the eclipse workspace (recommended eclipse framework is WebSphere integration developer)
- Is CPP/CPA editor packed with WebSphere Partner Gateway
 - Yes, it is packed with WebSphere Partner Gateway and is available in development kits/tools > delivery image folder




CPP/CPA is an editor that helps you in creating and modifying existing CPP/CPA. It is delivered as an eclipse plug-in and is packed with WebSphere Partner Gateway. It is available under development kits and tools of delivery image folder.



You will take a look at the preparatory activities before using CPP/CPA editor. You need to have eclipse framework with SWT libraries supporting 3.2 or above.




This presentation will now discuss the features supported by the CPP/CPA editor.




This editor supports creation and modification of CPP/CPA documents and creation of CPA by merging two CPPs.

Editor supports schema validation for CPP/CPA automatically on save. It supports content validation and displays the validation errors in a separate window so that you can rectify the problems.

Here, you will see how to make use of CPP/CPA editor for creating a new document. This editor populates CPP/CPA documents based on packed templates.


You are expected to modify the values as required.

How to create CPP/CPA document

- Click File > New > Other option
- In the CPAEditor category, select Collaboration Protocol Profile / Collaboration Protocol Agreement option
- Based on the above option, a wizard will guide you through the approach to collect basic details to create appropriate document





Here, you are going to see how to make use of CPP/CPA editor for creating CPA from two CPPs that already exist.

Select Merge Collaboration Protocol Profile wizard and provide existing CPPs as input.


The merged CPA is generated.


How one can create CPA from CPPs?

- Based on the guideline of auto merging of collaboration protocol profile, collaboration protocol agreement is generated


