IBM WebSphere Remote Server V7.1 contains eight offerings. The first four are the IBM Retail Store Server offerings. These contain IBM middleware with special pricing and usage restrictions that allow for cost-effective distribution to thousands of retail outlets.

The IBM WebSphere Central Site Server offering is intended for the enterprise or traditional back office and contains a full use license.

The IBM Tivoli Monitoring and Provisioning Add On for IBM Retail Store Server Edition is available to customers who purchase any of the IBM Retail Store Server offerings.

In the previous release of WebSphere Remote Server that included Tivoli products, the Tivoli products were bundled in the standard and advanced editions of WebSphere Remote Server. Now, the Tivoli products are included in this separate offering.

The last two offerings are IBM WebSphere Message Broker Retail Store Edition and IBM WebSphere Enterprise Service Bus Retail Store Edition. These offerings contain the individual products WebSphere Message Broker and WebSphere Enterprise Service Bus. Special licensing terms and conditions and special pricing apply. They can be purchased separately with or without purchasing any of the other WebSphere Remote Server offerings.



Both 32-bit and 64-bit operating systems are supported.

Note that the Windows Embedded POSReady 2009 operating system is available in 32-bit only.

Note that this is the same software that is included in the IBM Retail Store Server offerings without WebSphere sMash. Note also, there is no central site server offering that includes Informix Dynamic Server.

A new offering in IBM WebSphere Remote Server V7.1 is the IBM Tivoli Monitoring and Provisioning Add On for IBM Retail Store Server. This additional offering is available to customers who purchase any of the four IBM Retail Store Server offerings.

The software in this offering provides monitoring and software distribution capabilities.

Note that IBM Tivoli Composite Application Manager (ITCAM) for Applications V6.2.3 is actually a bundle of Tivoli products. WebSphere Remote Server V7.1 includes only a subset of this bundle.







- Maximum processor value units: 400
- Informix Dynamic Server: maximum processor value units: 200
- DB2: maximum RAM: 4 GB
- WebSphere Application Server Network Deployment
 - a. Licensee cannot use the Application Server Web Services Gateway.
 - b. Licensee cannot use Clustering, Deployment Manager and Job Manager functionality.
- For use in "stores" as defined by the licenses

Shown here are <u>some</u> of the usage restrictions for the starter editions.

The starter editions are restricted to usage on machines that have no more than 400 processor value units. Although the starter edition with Informix Dynamic Server is limited to 400 processor value units, Informix Dynamic Server itself is further restricted to 200 processor value units. This means if you want to run the other middleware products on a server or virtual server with up to 400 processor value units, you must install Informix Dynamic Server on a separate server or server partition. Informix Dynamic Server must be on a server, virtual server, or server partition with a maximum of 200 processor value units.

The license permits you to run DB2 on servers with up to 4 GB of RAM. The capabilities of WebSphere Application Server Network Deployment are restricted to those of WebSphere Application Server Express[®].

The processor cores running any of the IBM Retail Store Server offerings must physically reside in a store as defined by the licenses.

 - Maximum processor value units: 480
 - DB2: maximum RAM: 16 GB
- IBM Retail Store Server Advanced Edition with Informix Dynamic Server V7.1

- All IBM Retail Store Server offerings are for use in "stores" as defined by the licenses

Shown here are <u>some</u> of the usage restrictions for the advanced editions.

The IBM Retail Store Server Advanced Edition V7.1 is restricted to usage on servers or virtual servers that have no more than 480 processor value units. The license permits you to run DB2 on servers or virtual servers with up to 16 GB of RAM.

The IBM Retail Store Server Advanced Edition with Informix Dynamic Server V7.1 is restricted to usage on servers or virtual servers that have no more than 400 processor value units.

The processor cores running any of the IBM Retail Store Server offerings must physically reside in a store as defined by the licenses.

Again refer to the IBM WebSphere Remote Server licenses for complete details.



Other usage restrictions


- The following WebSphere Remote Server editions are restricted to usage on servers or virtual servers rated at 400 processor value units or less:
 - IBM WebSphere Message Broker Retail Store Edition
 - IBM WebSphere Enterprise Service Bus Retail Store Edition
 - IBM Tivoli Monitoring and Provisioning Add On for IBM Retail Store Server, if IBM Retail Store Server Starter Edition was purchased as a prerequisite
- The following WebSphere Remote Server editions are restricted to usage on servers or virtual servers rated at 480 processor value units or less:
 - IBM Tivoli Monitoring and Provisioning Add On for IBM Retail Store Server, if IBM Retail Store Server Advanced Edition was purchased as a prerequisite

Shown here are restrictions for the other offerings.

The IBM WebSphere Message Broker and IBM WebSphere Enterprise Service Bus retail store editions are restricted to 400 processor value units.

The usage restriction for the IBM Tivoli Monitoring and Provisioning Add On for IBM Retail Store Server depends on the edition of retail store server that you purchased.

The systems management accelerators are software that is included with the IBM Retail Store Server and WebSphere Central Site Server offerings. The accelerators allow you to install the IBM software products as a single solution rather than installing each product separately. It also allows for automated migration from previous releases of WebSphere Remote Server.


The development environment allows you to customize the solution. You can tailor the solution to your needs and create your own DVD for distribution.

Tivoli software packages are provided for distributing the solution using Tivoli Provisioning Manager. A TPMRMA-bridge utility is provided for distribution of software from Tivoli Provisioning Manager to IBM Remote Management Agent. This provides software distribution capability from the enterprise to devices in the store. IBM Remote Management Agent is not included in WebSphere Remote Server.

Note these Tivoli enhancements are only of use if you have also purchased the Tivoli Monitoring and Provisioning Add On offering.

Log collection scripts are provided to collect log files from the various IBM software products for transmission to IBM customer support.

In V7.1, support was added to the systems management accelerators for 64-bit operating systems.



Shown here is an example of a systems management accelerators DVD.

There are four systems management accelerators DVDs included in each of IBM Retail Store Server offerings and in the IBM WebSphere Central Site Server offering. Each DVD targets a particular operating system; Windows 32-bit and 64-bit and Linux for Intel® 32-bit and 64-bit.

Each DVD is labeled with the brand, "WebSphere," followed by the offering name, for example "Retail Store Server Advanced Edition."

Near the bottom you will see "This DVD contains System management accelerators for" and the type of operating system.

Use the appropriate DVD for your operating system.


