Product overview

IBM[®] Business Monitor Pattern is a virtual pattern configuration of Business Monitor that provides business monitoring capabilities that are configured for typical business monitoring projects.

A *virtual pattern* is a system-centric or application-centric pattern that you build to define the resources that are required to support software, including web applications, databases, and user registries. To build a virtual pattern, you use pattern artifacts, such as software components, script packages, links, and policies, and you specify quality-of-service levels. You then use the virtual pattern to create, deploy, and manage IBM Business Monitor environments.

Step 1: Access the software and documentation

After you download the IBM Business Monitor Pattern package from IBM Passport Advantage[®], go to Patterns for IBM Business Process Management (http://www.ibm.com/support/docview.wss?uid=swg27036093), and under **Patterns for IBM Business Process Management**, follow the instructions for the appropriate version and operating system.
