Product overview

IBM® BPM Application Pattern is a virtual application pattern configuration of IBM BPM Advanced, V8.5. A virtual application pattern is a model that you build. To build the model, you use application artifacts, such as components, links, and policies, and quality-of-service levels. Use these virtual application patterns to create, deploy, and manage IBM BPM environments. IBM BPM Application Pattern provides business process management capabilities that are configured for typical business process management projects.

Step 1: Access the software and documentation

2 Step 2: Evaluate the hardware and system configuration



IBM BPM Application Patterns run on IBM PureApplication[™] System W1500, V1.1.0.0 and later fix packs.

3 Step 3: Install IBM BPM Application Patterns



To install IBM BPM Application Pattern, complete the following steps:

- 1. Go to the IBM Passport Advantage website and locate the *Business Process Manager Application Pattern* package, BPM_APP_PATTERN_V85_RHEL_X64.tgz. This compressed file contains the application model, provisioning scripts, and installation media to install on a Windows or Linux operating system.
- 2. Download the package from Passport Advantage to an http server. Note the location so that you can refer to the web address during the installation process.
- 3. Log on to the Workload Console of IBM PureApplication System.
- 4. Click **Cloud** > **Pattern Types** to open the Pattern types window.
- 5. Install the IBM BPM pattern type. Click the Add icon.
- 6. On the **Remote** tab of the Install a pattern type window, enter the web address where you downloaded the IBM BPM Application Pattern package.
- 7. Verify that **IBM BPM Pattern Type 8.5** is listed on the left of the Pattern types window.
- 8. SelectIBM BPM Pattern Type 8.5 and accept the licenses.
- 9. Click Catalog > Virtual Application Templates to open the Virtual Application Templates window.
- 10. Select **IBM BPM Pattern Type 8.5** on the Virtual Application Templates window and verify the installation by locating the following IBM BPM virtual application templates:
 - Process Center
 - Process Application
 - Process Application with Existing Process Center
 - Process Application with External Database
