

## Quick Start Guide

*Get started installing and configuring IBM Business Monitor V8.5.5*

### Product overview

IBM® Business Monitor is a comprehensive business activity monitoring (BAM) software product that provides a real-time view of your business performance. Personalized business dashboards display the current state of your business and can alert you when predefined business situations are detected. Using the dashboards, you can also see key performance indicators (KPIs) that consolidate results across time to reveal trends and offer predictions, and you can view sophisticated reports based on embedded Cognos® Business Intelligence technology. The events and data that feed these dashboards can be collected from various sources, including, but not limited to, IBM Business Process Manager (BPM), IBM WebSphere® Operational Decision Management, and WebSphere Message Broker. In addition, you can use adapters to collect events from additional sources, such as SAP.

### 1 Step 1: Access the software and documentation

### 2 Step 2: Evaluate the hardware and system configuration

### 3 Step 3: Installing IBM Business Monitor



To prepare for a typical installation of Business Monitor on your development and production systems, complete the following steps:

1. Obtain the compressed files from the DVDs or from the downloaded images, and then extract all the files from the compressed files to the same location on your hard disk. You might be prompted to overwrite directories.
2. Start the Business Monitor installation program:
  - On Microsoft Windows, run `1aunchpad64.exe` from the root directory.
  - On AIX®, Linux, and Solaris, run `1aunchpad.sh` from the root directory.
3. Review the information on the different panels in the launchpad.
4. Follow the instructions to install Business Monitor.
