

Buyable Pins

- Pinterest introduced Buyable Pins in June 2015 for US retailers and buyers
- When a product is buyable, the price appears in bold, blue to the user and a "Buy it" button is shown next to the "Pin it" button
- This allows a quick buying experience, right from the mobile Pinterest app
- A downloadable asset is available from the <u>IBM</u> <u>ExperienceOne developerWorks Community</u>
- This asset is built for WebSphere Commerce V7 FEP8 and later, but can be modified for earlier versions that supports REST services





Architecture

- The integration is built via a set of REST services exposed by WC with two new resources:
 - /pinterest/carts
 - Interact (create/update/delete/show) with a user's shopping cart
 - /pinterest/products
 - Get details for a particular product
- The API allows for fine-grained as well as bulk changes to an order
 - Create order with items, quantities, shipping address
 - Retrieve a list of supported shipping modes
 - Add coupons, shipping modes, shipping address
 - Place order, including payment information

/carts/{cartId}/pay	POST	Add payment information and submit order	Payment instruction
<pre>/products/{partNumber}</pre>	GET	Retrieve details for a product	



Creating a cart

Pinterest will call this API to create a new cart with the specified items and quantities. WC will create a new cart and add the items. If an address is specified, it is added to the cart

```
URL:
/store/{storeId}/pinterest/carts/{cartId}/available_shipping_options
```

POST data:

```
data: {
    cart: {
        cart_items: [
            {
            item: partnumber,
            quantity: quantity
        },
        ...
    ],
    cart_shipping_detail: ...
    }
}
```



Listing shipping methods

- Pinterest will call this API to create a new cart with the specified items and quantities. WC will create a new cart and add the items. If an address is specified, it is added to the cart
- URL: /store/{storeId}/pinterest/carts
- Returns cart data, including shipping methods



Updating a cart

- Pinterest will call this API to create a new cart with the specified items and quantities. WC will create a new cart and add the items. If an address is specified, it is added to the cart
- URL: /store/{storeId}/pinterest/carts/{cartId}
- POST data (all optional):

```
data: {
    cart: {
        cart_items: ...,
        cart_shipping_detail: ...,
        coupons: ...,
        shipping_option_id, ...
    }
}
```



Adoption

- Download asset from wiki page (see references)
- Modify to suit your particular store, as needed
 - Note that this is an Accelerator asset, so you should ensure that you have sufficiently tested the code in your environments
- Contact Pinterest to set up an arrangement to sell items through their mobile apps



Customization

 The asset is available with full source code and can thus be customized to suit any specific requirements



Troubleshooting

- Using standard REST and Order frameworks, so existing troubleshooting for these frameworks apply
- For the asset itself, adding the following trace string will output all interactions:

```
com.ibm.commerce.pinterest.rest.carts.*=all
```

• The code is available, so additional tracing can be added as needed
