Microsoft Online Solutions Are Not Designed For Extranet Collaboration

- Businesses purchase services for own use
 - Data is stored in each companies own domain
 - Limited to 5000 users
 - Extra charges apply for additional domain usage
- No sense of 'working groups' that spans corporate boundaries
 - Cannot search across services for people or data
 - Can only work with people in own organization
 - Cannot find a person in another company
 - Completely separate identity needed to join another user group
 - No "guest" accounts
 - No integration between services
 - Store documents in separate company team sites
 - No methods for searching or sharing across sites


Microsoft Live Meeting Can Be Disjointed, Cumbersome And Time-Consuming

- Full Live Meeting rich client required for complete functionality set
 - For newer files, rich client required for conversion
- Cannot easily display Microsoft's own native Office formats
 - Lengthy file conversion required before upload
- No integration with other online collaboration
 - File storage separated from meetings service
 - Requires file download; yields multiple file copies
 - No online community for invitees; must navigate to email application to find colleagues
 - Different user experience and terminology between Live Meetings, SharePoint Online and Exchange Online


