Preface

Metamerge Integrator is now owned and supported by International Business Machines Corporation.

Known Issues 4.6.8

This is a description of major, unfixed problems. Newest issues are added at the top. When workarounds are available, they are published here, as are early versions of fixes for bugs.

Items are removed from this list as Service Packs provide remedies for them. See "Service Packs" in *Metamerge Integrator 4.6.8: Fixed Issues* for more information about fixed issues. Fixed issues are available in *Metamerge Integrator 4.6.8: FAQ*.

Delta on iterator

The Delta configuration works for the first component only. The first component is the first component added to the AssemblyLine in the current session which is still not removed.

This bug is fixed in the release 4.7.

Workaround

Do the following:

1. Move the Iterator you want to configure to the top of the AssemblyLine by selecting it and clicking the up arrow button.
2. Save your configuration file.
3. Restart the Admin tool (the Iterator is now the first known Connector as the Admin tool reads the configuration file).
4. Configure the Delta of the Iterator.
5. Move the Iterator back where it must be, using the down arrow button.

Logged in 4.6.7, present since 4.6.

Memory leak

Each time an AssemblyLine is started, approximately 2.5 KB of memory is lost. Typically, this is something that causes problems when you have a configuration file with an EventHandler starting AssemblyLines again and again.

In addition, if you run the AssemblyLines from the Admin tool, the log-window uses a lot of memory. You might want to close the log-window to free this memory.

Workaround

Close down and restart the Metamerge Integrator Server when you are getting low on memory.

Integrator 4.7 and later has remedied this issue, as it has to do with an external library (BSF) used by Metamerge Integrator. The newest BSF version (version 2.2) has the necessary functionality to remedy this memory leak.

Logged in version 4.6.4, present since the beginning.
