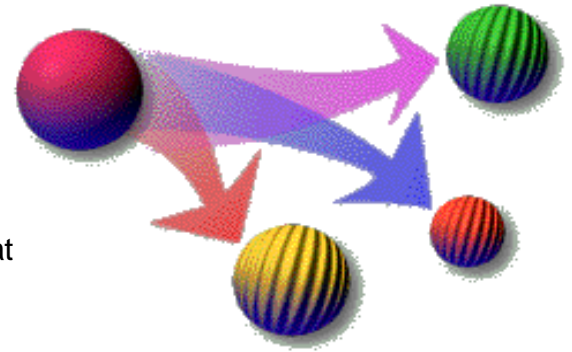


IBM Global Sign-On™ (GSO)

IBM's Global Sign-On (GSO) is a secure, easy-to-use product that grants users access to the computing resources they are authorized to use --- **with just one logon**. Designed for large enterprises consisting of multiple heterogeneous systems and applications managed by Tivoli, GSO eliminates the need for end-users to manage multiple logon IDs and passwords.

Overview

GSO authenticates a user with a single ID and password. After authentication, GSO displays the systems, applications, and databases that the user has been given access to. When the user selects a system or application, GSO automatically completes the logins to those environments.

Features

GSO Version 2.0 includes the following capabilities:

- Integrated support for Tivoli User Administration, Tivoli Software Distribution and Tivoli Events Management
- Support for multiple clients including OS/2, Windows NT and Windows 95
- Compatible with a wide range of targets, including 3270/5250 host applications; OS/2 Warp Server; OS/2 LAN Server 4.x; NetWare 3.x and 4.x; Windows NT Server; Lotus Notes 4.x; PeopleSoft applications; DB2, Informix, MS SQL Server, Oracle and Sybase databases; and local operating systems
