

### Change is disruptive when not properly managed

IT skills shortage reaches highest level in 10 years

50% of outsourced projects are expected to under perform




Estimated 70-80% of IT budget is on maintenance









A = Short time frame tactical thoughts - underestimated real life workload over time for transactions


B = Majority of customers run in this quadrant




