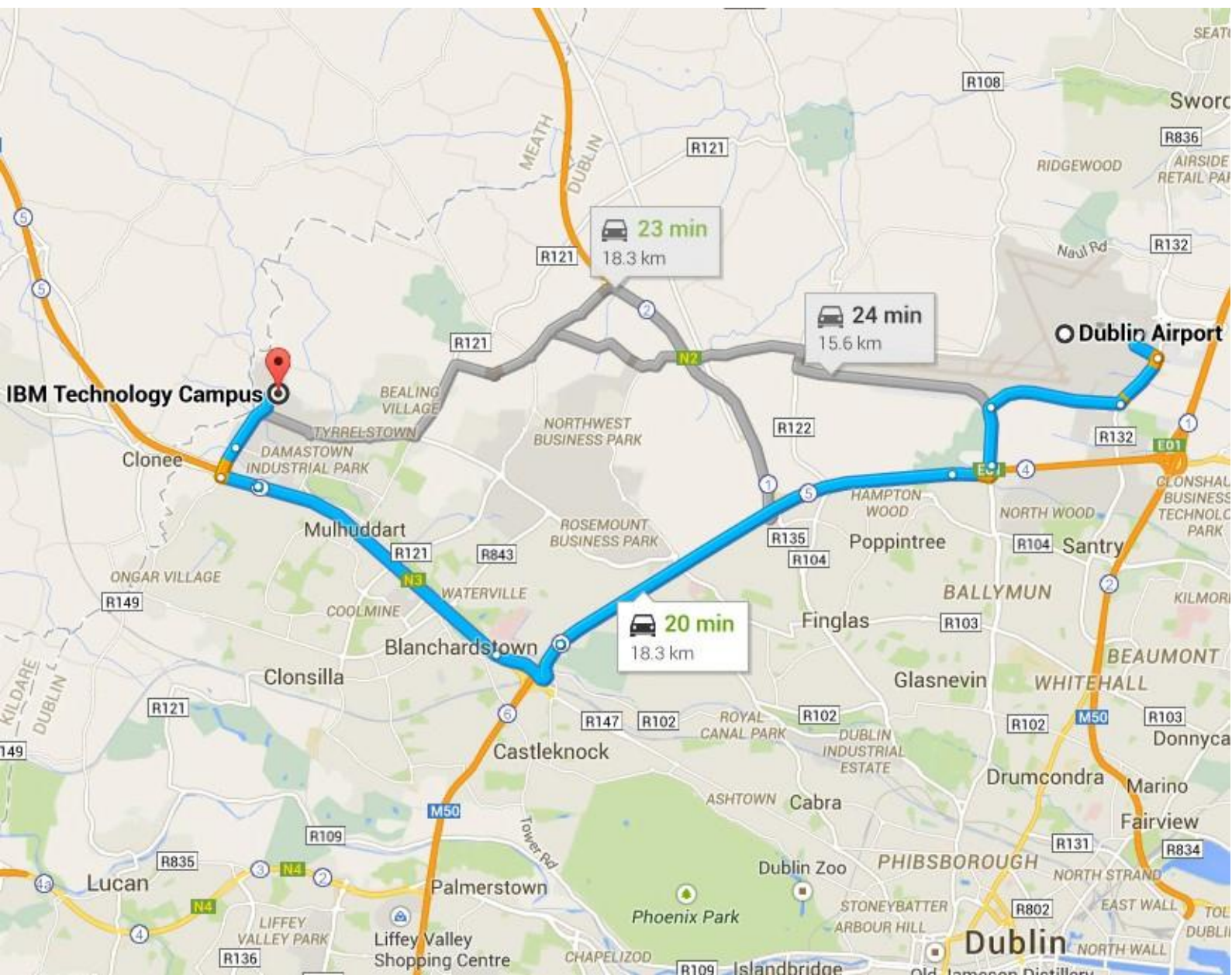

Take **M1 South** towards city centre and join **M50 Southbound**.

Use **Exit 6 (N3 / Navan)** and get on N3 towards Navan.

Take **Exit 4 from N3**, turn right at the exit ramp to cross over N3.
