

## Quick Start Guide

### Product overview

With IBM® Rational® Programming Patterns, you can develop and maintain VisualAge® Pacbase V3.5 applications in a strategic, open environment based on Eclipse and Jazz™. It integrates with IBM Rational Developer for System z® or IBM Rational Developer for AIX® and Linux, according to your environment. It always requires an integration with IBM Rational Team Concert™.

### 1 Step 1: Access your software

### 3 Step 3: Evaluate your hardware and system configuration

Before installing IBM Rational Programming Patterns, you must check the system requirements of the products it is integrated with and install these products.

To install the IBM Rational Programming Patterns client, you must install:

1. One of the following client products, according to your environment:
  - IBM Rational Developer for System z V9.0 for a System z environment. You can refer to its Quick Start Guide (GI11-8300-07), available on the IBM Rational Developer for System z Quick Start Disk.
  - IBM Rational Developer for AIX and Linux V9.0 for a System p® environment. You can refer to its Quick Start Guide (CF3TWML), available on the IBM Rational Developer for AIX and Linux Quick Start Disk.
2. IBM Rational Team Concert client version 4.0.3. Refer to its Quick Start Guide (CF3SGML), available on the IBM Rational Team Concert Quick Start Disk.

To install the IBM Rational Programming Patterns server, you must install the Jazz Team Server and CCM Application version 4.0.3. Refer to the IBM Rational Team Concert Quick Start Guide (CF3SGML), available on the IBM Rational Team Concert Quick Start Disk.

## 4 Step 4: Install the IBM Rational Programming Patterns client



You must install the IBM Rational Programming Patterns client where the other client products are already installed.

You can install the IBM Rational Programming Patterns client on Windows Vista, Windows XP Professional, or Windows 7, from an installation disk or an electronic image. Refer to the IBM Rational Programming Patterns Installation Guide (GC14-7413-03).

## 5 Step 5: Install the IBM Rational Programming Patterns server



You must install the IBM Rational Programming Patterns server where the Jazz Team Server is already installed.

You can install the IBM Rational Programming Patterns server on Windows 2008, UNIX, Linux, or zLinux from an installation disk or an electronic image. Refer to the IBM Rational Programming Patterns Installation Guide (GC14-7413-03).

You can also install the IBM Rational Programming Patterns server on z/OS, through SMP/E. Refer to the installation instructions found in the Rational Programming Patterns Program Directory (GI11-9155-03).

## 6 Step 6: Integrate with IBM Rational Team Concert



To integrate IBM Rational Programming Patterns with IBM Rational Team Concert, you must create language definitions that are specific to IBM Rational Programming Patterns. Refer to the IBM Rational Programming Patterns Installation Guide (GC14-7413-03).
