Description:	<p>This iFix includes fixes for APAR IP23680, plus fixes in all previous iFixes except for iFix OPDM-09.01.00-009 (see Special Notes).</p> <p>The following fixes are part of IP23680:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Multiple fixes for convert service editor.• Embedded Manager now updates the service status on the service monitoring tab after successful execution. <p>The following fixes are included from previous iFixes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fixed to allow launching the Optim Manager from within the Optim Designer and the application server when the hosting system does not have internet access.• Fixed Optim Designer to load modified feature plugins updated by the iFix process.• Added ability to treat DB2 nickname objects as tables.• Fixed a problem with creating and saving an insert service from an access definition that had no default qualifier.• Fixed creation of an extract service that uses an access definition with an Optim relationship that has not been upgraded into Designer.• Fixed multiple table map editor problems related to the source file.

Co-requisites:	OPDM-09.01.00-014 (Web applications patch)
Supersedes:	All previous iFixes except for iFix OPDM-09.01.00-009.
Special Notes:	iFix OPDM-09.01.00-009 can be installed before or after this iFix if desired. It is <u>not</u> a pre-requisite or co-requisite of this iFix.

Corrective Actions:	
Section I	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Extract this zip file to a directory. For example: c:\temp\OPDM-09.01.00-014DesignerPatch2. Open a command prompt for the directory <install_dir>\IBM\Installation Manager\eclipse3. Run the command: IBMIM -input c:\temp\OPDM-09.01.00-014DesignerPatch\install.xml4. When Installation Manager starts, click Update to start the Update wizard.

5. Continue through the Update wizard to install the fix.
6. Verify the patch has installed successfully
 - a) In Installation Manager, select the File Menu
 - b) Select “View Installed Packages.” The Installed Packages dialog will appear.
 - c) You should see the patch installed.
7. Find the Optim Designer shortcut in the Start menu.
8. Right-click on the shortcut and select Properties. You will see a dialog of properties for the shortcut.
9. On the Shortcut tab, go to the Target field and add “-clean” at the end. Make sure there is a space before the “-clean” option.
10. Click OK to close the dialog.
11. After you run Designer for the first time, you can choose to follow the steps above to remove the “-clean” option. It is only needed the first time after an installation. If you leave it in, starting up Designer will be slower.
