


1 About this Documentation

1.1 Audience

The target audience of this document is IBM Performance Manager for Wireless customers. They should be familiar with telecommunication and IT principles and should also have a good understanding of Solaris.

IMPORTANT: Before attempting an installation of Performance Manager for Wireless you are strongly advised to read release notes and any readme file distributed with your Performance Manager for Wireless software. Readme files and release note may contain information specific to your installation not contained in installation *Tivoli Netcool Performance Manager Technology Package Installation Notes*. Failure to consult readme files and release notes may result in a corrupt, incomplete or failed installation.

Note: Performance Manager for Wireless Administrators should not, without prior consultation and agreement from IBM, make any changes to the Index Organized tables or database schema. Changes to the Index Organized tables or database schema may result in corruption of data and failure of the Performance Manager for Wireless System. This applies to all releases of Performance Manager for Wireless using all versions of interfaces.

2.2.2 Gateway Configuration Patch Implementation

To implement the gateway configuration patch, please follow the following instruction:-

- 1. Backup the existing EngineConfig.pm with a meaningful name.

 \$ mv EngineConfig.pm EngineConfig.pm.GC340
- 2. Copy EngineConfig.pm from this patch to correspond \$Gateway_DIR/motorola-ggsn/v50/ directory.

2.3 Technology Pack Patch

This section explains the procedure to implement this Technology Pack Patch on a step by step basis. Please read each section and subsection carefully.

2.3.1 Pre-requisite Requirements

Before installing this technology pack, the following GOM technology packs must be installed and in the following sequence.

2. Copy the SummaryInstancePCalcs.xml file from SUMMARIES/ in the Patch package into the following location:

/appl/virtuo/admin/techpacks/GPRS_Motorola_GGSN_v050/2.0. 0/summaries

2.3.2 Technology Pack Patch Implementation

1. Display the running loader.

2. Stop the related running loader. In this case, loadgprsmotorolaggsn_v50.
