Product Overview

IBM® WebSphere® Extended Deployment Compute Grid uses service level management to provide an enhanced quality of service in running and controlling batch-like jobs in Compute Grid. The product also offers flexible support for mixed application types. A new batch-like job referred to as native execution is now supported. WebSphere Extended Deployment Compute Grid workload management technology can support a diverse mix of application types while ensuring service levels are met for priority requests.

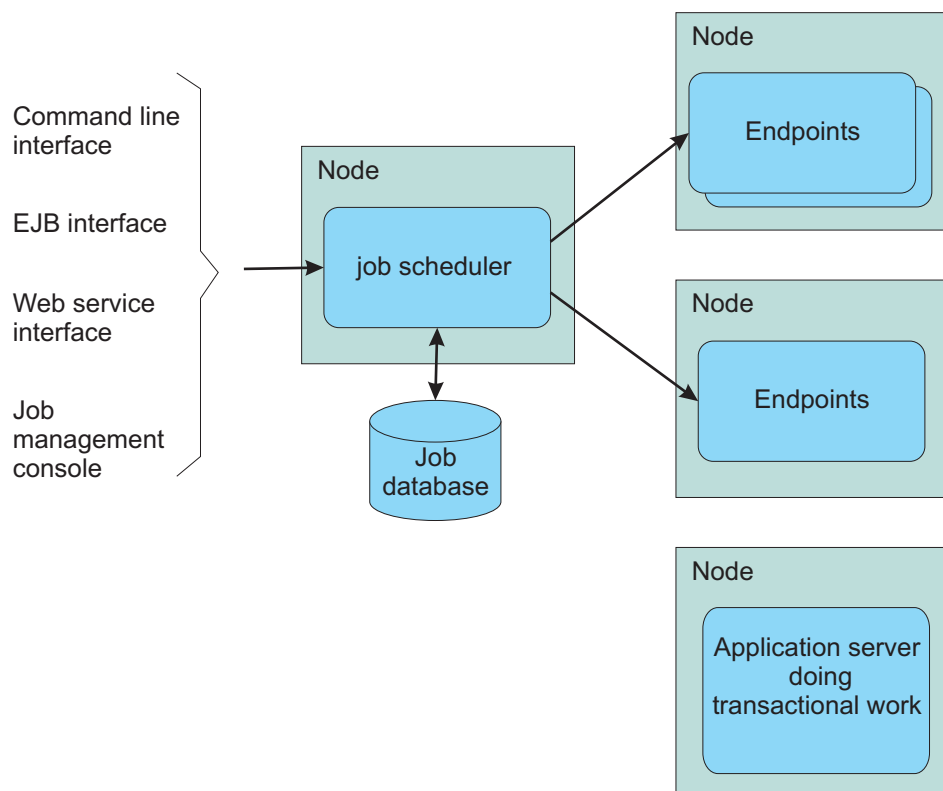
