



## License Update for WebSphere Application Server v7.0

---

The purpose of this Update to the WebSphere Application Server v7.0 License Agreement is to modify the 2 server failover restriction currently in the Program license.

The following is currently included in the Restricted Use Component section of the WAS Program's License Information:

"You are entitled to use the WebServer Plugins to improve security by having an HTTP server run on a separate machine from the Program. You are authorized to configure a WebServer Plugin to multiple application servers only for the purpose of simple load balancing and failover. Simple load balancing and failover enables the WebServer Plugin to route requests to a maximum of two application servers and is limited to HTTP session failover only."

The language is updated as follows:

"You are entitled to use the WebServer Plugins to improve security by having an HTTP server run on a separate machine from the Program. You are authorized to merge the plugins for up to twenty five (25) application servers into a single plugin file for the HTTP server. Further, within the WebServer Plugin, any simple load balancing and failover must be limited to routing requests to a maximum of five (5) application servers and is limited to HTTP requests only. Each WebSphere Application Server used in this failover scenario must be appropriately licensed."

The terms of this Update are in addition to and may modify (for the purposes of this Attachment only) those of the Associated Documents (defined below) which govern the terms and pricing for the IBM Programs subject to this Update. Except as modified herein, all other terms of the Associated Documents remain in full force and effect.

The following comprise the "Associated Documents":

1. Your IBM International Passport Advantage Agreement ("PA")
2. Your IBM International Program License Agreement ("IPLA").

IBM may audit your compliance with this Update per the terms of the Associated Documents.
