Consolidation results in improved processes when it implements voice technology

The Need:

The customer needed to maintain a competitive position in the food and beverage industry and planned to expand by tripling their store locations worldwide. To achieve this goal, four regional US distribution centers consolidated operations to enable the efficiencies needed.

The Solution:

Optimizing the supply chain using IBM WebSphere Portal and IBM BP VAI S2K Enterprise ERP system, they were able to do store replenishment allowing the flow of data through the supply chain to run in parallel to the flow of goods.

What Makes it Smarter:

- The real-time voice picking system is hands-free, eyes-free, has speech recognition and enables real-time stock updating, which allows the triggering of letdowns to replenish picking faces.
- Accuracy to at least 99.9% (one error per thousand picks)
- Multiple language capability improves productivity allowing employees to choose the language they want
