Start Monitors → Create Warning Events


- Endpoint
- Resource
- Threshold to high/low values & critical/warning


Event Action


- 1. Text message
- 2. Email
- 3. Run a script → name, path, command, parameters
 - Put script on your machine

Automation Plan

- Select Event
- Set Time range → 24 hours or specific hours
- Action
