Problem description

This flash addresses a problem with using the Recover command in a Global Mirror session.

An issue was found affecting the Recover processing of ALL TotalStorage® Productivity Center for Replication sessions that use Global Mirror

This issue might affect users who have Global Mirror sessions as part of their solution. Global Mirror sessions include the following:

- Global Mirror Single Direction
- Global Mirror Failover/Failback
- Global Mirror Failover/Failback with Practice
- Metro Global Mirror

A severe issue has been identified during the processing of a Recover command, in which consistency group formation for a Global Mirror session is stopped or abruptly terminated. This problem might result in TotalStorage Productivity Center for Replication incorrectly reverting the FlashCopy® relationships. Although this is an unusual event, it is **strongly encouraged** that all users running Global Mirror apply fix 3.4.1.3 to ensure that the Recover process provides data consistency across the session.
