SUBJECT: Update Recommendation to Release or Transfer to the Control of Another Country for Continued Detention (TR) for Guantanamo Detainee, ISN: US9AG-000070DP (S)

1. (FOUO) Personal Information:

- JDIMS/NDRRC Reference Name: Abdul Rahmm Houari
- Aliases and Current/True Name: Huwari Mustafa Abdel Rahman, Sofiane Haderbache, and Guerri Farid.
- Place of Birth: Algers, Algeria (AG)
- Date of Birth: 18 January 1980
- Citizenship: Algeria (AG)

2. (FOUO) Health:

a. History: 24 year old Algerian with history of significant penetrating head trauma in 2001 with resultant blindness in right eye and shrapnel injuries to the frontal portion of his brain, causing difficulty with speech and understanding as well as loss of inhibitions e.g. disrobing in public, urinating on floor, etc.

b. Treatment: Detainee has had ongoing behavioral services interventions, is currently on zyprexa, an anti-psychotic; neuropsychological assessment completed on 24 June 04.

c. Function: Detainee is mobile yet has slowed motor functions and generally needs assistance with caring for himself and supervision for his safety; attention and concentration are mildly impaired.

d. Prognosis: Detainee will need some form of custodial care long-term; current recommendation is for a rehabilitation facility experienced with brain injuries.

3. (S) Detainee Summary:

- a. (S) Detention Information: Same as stated in JTF CG memo, dated 27 March 2004.
- b. (S) Prior Assessment: On 27 March 2004, BG Jay W. Hood, Commander, JTF Guantanamo, recommended that detainee be considered for transfer to the control of another country for continued detention.
- c. (S) Intelligence Value: JTF GTMO has determined that this detainee is of medium intelligence value.


4. (S) Detainee's Conduct: Detainee's has a history of non-compliance and aggressiveness. He has been informed to keep his clothes on and has repeatedly disregarded those orders and has stood in his cell naked. Detainee has many instances of masturbating in front of others without the slightest bit of self-consciousness.

5. (S) EC Status: Detainee's enemy combatant status was reassessed on 24 February 2004, and he remains an enemy combatant.

6. (S) JTF GTMO New Assessment:

- a. (S) Summary: JTF GTMO has determined that the detainee poses a low risk, due to his medical condition.
- b. (S) Recommendation: Based on the detainee's health status, intelligence value and risk level, JTF GTMO recommends this detainee be released or transferred to the control of another country for continued detention.

7. (S) Coordination: JTF GTMO notified the Criminal Investigative Task Force (CITF) of this recommendation on 25 June 2004. JTF GMTMO and CITF agree on the threat assessment of this detainee as a medium risk.
