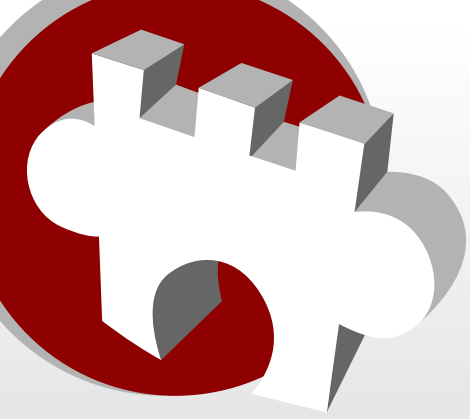
# 2010

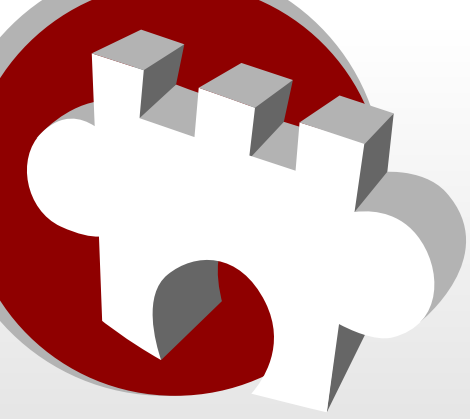

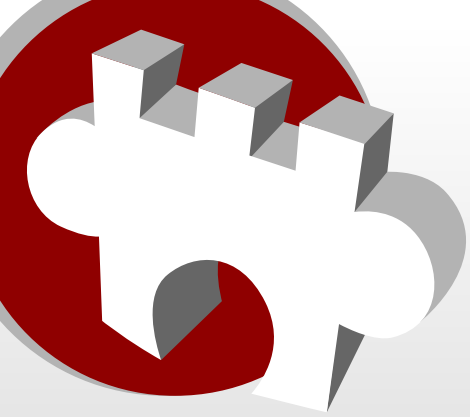




## Goals (2)

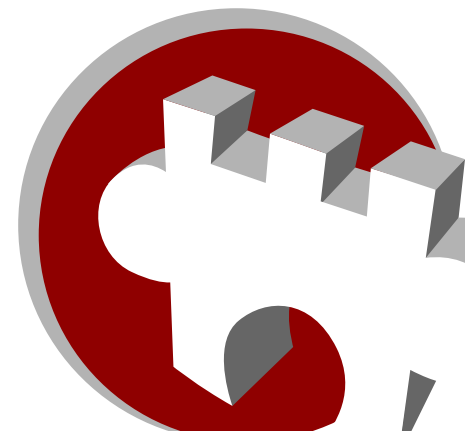

## 5 contest rules

1. Pictures have to be self-taken and self-uploaded;
2. Upload available in September *only*;
3. Default licence is CC-BY-SA 3.0 (localised);
4. Pictures have to be identified by a locally determined identifier;
5. Participants need to have their e-mail enabled.

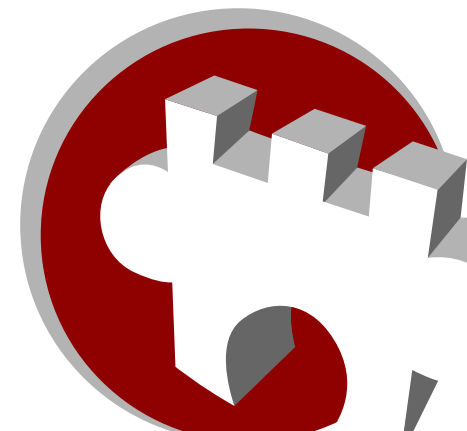
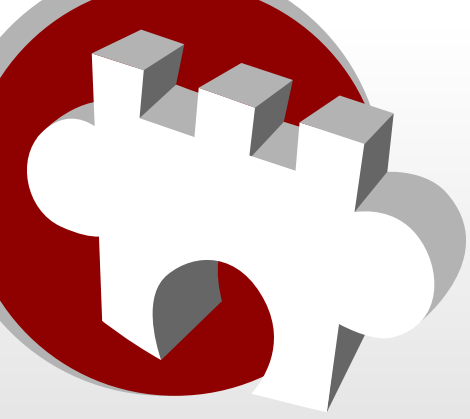
Not: minimum resolution in pixels, minimal quality, date of creation.

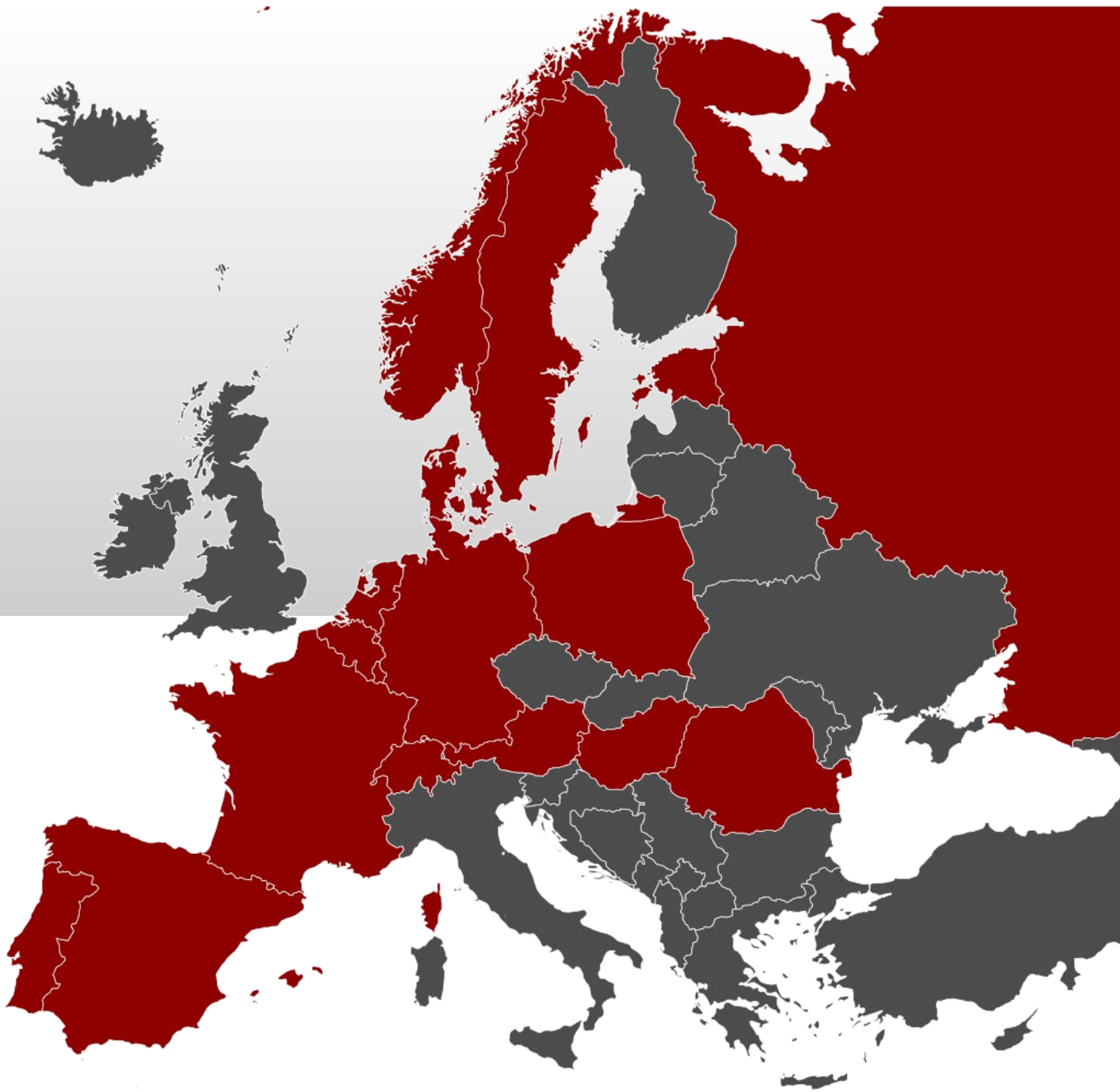




# 2011

- 18 European countries;
- 14 different Wikipedias;
- Hundreds of Wikipedians organising locally;
- About 5,000 participants;
- 1 month (September 1–September 30);
- Over 167,000 photos – a new world record!

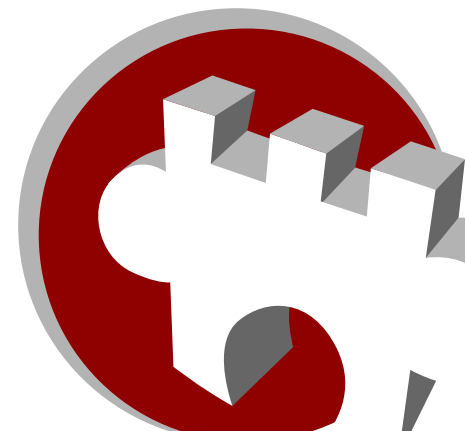

- 350,000 photos



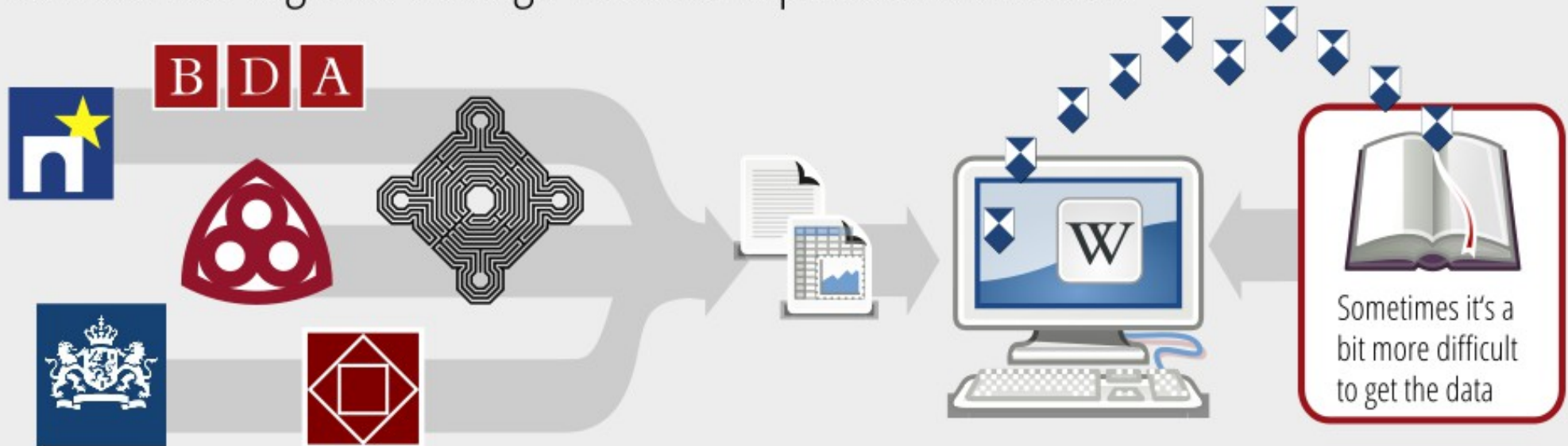

National and regional heritage institutions provide official data





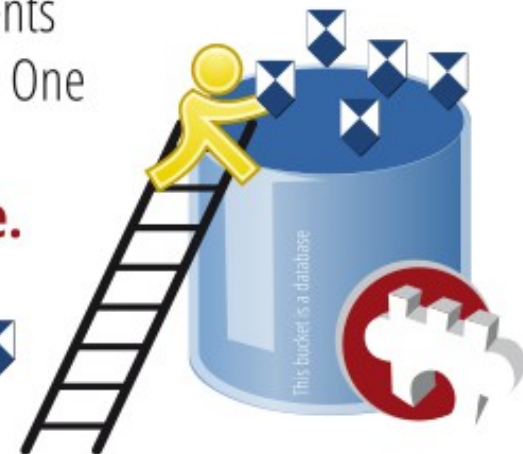

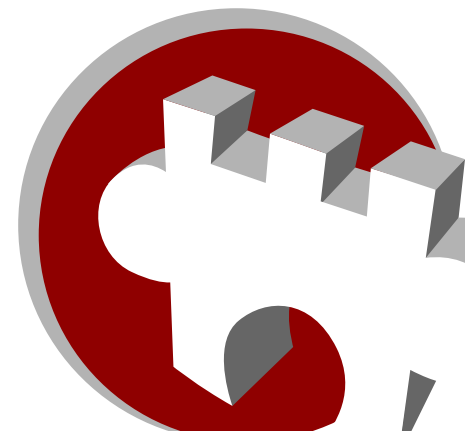

# Monuments database

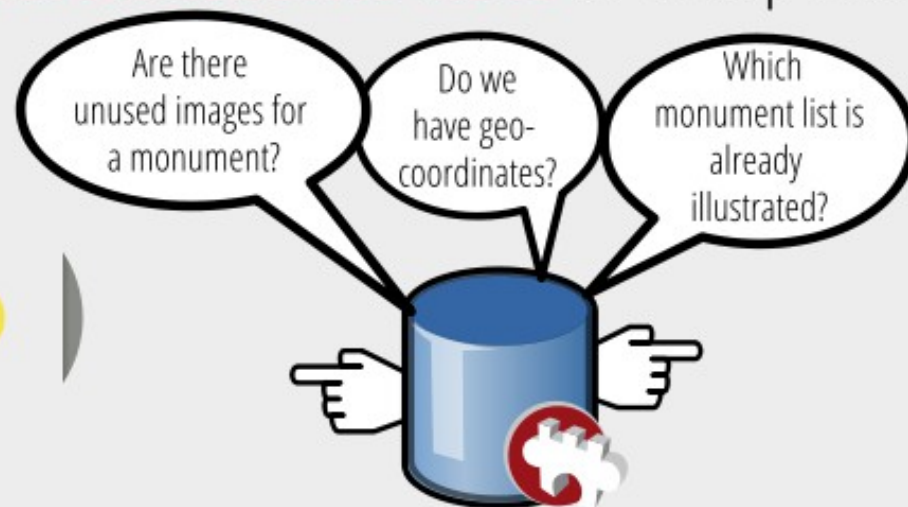
- 40+ sources
