- Sign your posts with four tildas (~~~~) This will automatically add your username and a timestamp to your post.
- Offer advice about how to improve the article with well-reasoned explanations.
- Start new posts at the bottom of the "Talk" page, beginning each new section with a section name relevant to the topic and set apart from previous sections by a second-level header (e.g. "==Copyediting suggestions==").
- Identify yourself as a new user.

Copyediting questions:

- How can the sentences be made more concise?
- How can the sentence structure be made more varied?
- How can the sentence structures better emphasize the important ideas?
- How can the diction be made more precise?
- Are there any grammar errors that need fixing?
- Are there any spelling and punctuation errors that need fixing?
