



Wiki Loves Monuments is an international photo competition around cultural heritage, organised by the volunteer community of Wikipedia, the world's largest on-line encyclopedia. Wikipedia and its sister projects, like Wikimedia Commons, are funded through voluntary donations and developed thanks to the involvement of thousands of volunteers from around the world.

This calendar is a great example of using and redistributing free-licenced photographs from Wikimedia Commons, a collection of almost 15 million media files. It features impressive images of cultural heritage monuments (heritage sites) that were chosen as the first 13 winners of the international finale of *Wiki Loves Monuments* 2012.

The contest was organised in 35 countries from all over the world, resulting in more than 350,000 pictures being submitted by more than 15,000 people. All of the pictures,

including those visible in this calendar, are free for further use, distribution and modification under the terms of the Creative Commons Attribution-ShareAlike (CC-BY-SA) 3.0 licence.

We are very proud to see that the contest has grown to so many different participating countries, which is clearly reflected in the diversity amongst the winners. Our thanks go to all the volunteer organisers, participants, partners and sponsors that helped make *Wiki Loves Monuments* 2012 the largest photography competition in history.
